Lake Olympia Usage Restrictions

Boats

- All boats used on the lake, must be registered at the Marina office. A sticker will be issued for placement on the boat.
- Absolutely **no boats with gas engines** are allowed on the lake. The exception to this rule is our hired lake management company or other maintenance companies employed by LOCA.
- Boats are limited to a **maximum 18ft in length and 10ft in width**.
- Boats with large electric motors should maintain a speed so as not to create a wake that reaches the shoreline.
- No gas or electric personal watercraft is allowed on the lake. These typically are referred by the brand names WaveRunner, Jet Ski, or Sea-Doo.
- Boat slips at the marina are only to be used by residents. **LOCA is not responsible for any theft or damage to the boats that are left at the marina.**
- Boats kept at the marina or at private docks, should be properly maintained. This includes removing litter and dipping out any rainwater so boats are not half sunken under water.

Fishing

- **Release** all Largemouth Bass. The population of this sport fish is dwindling and we cannot build it up if people remove them from the lake.
- Cast nets can be used to capture baitfish but only Shad should be taken with them. Do not take Perch, Bluegill, Crappie or any other game fish. This is against the law.
- Trotlines, yo-yos, jugs or any trigger devices **are not allowed** on the lake for taking any fish. **These unattended devices will be removed.**

General

- Guests (non-residents) may only use LOCA facilities if a resident accompanies them.
- Do not invite your friends to fish or use the lake unless you accompany them. They could be charged with trespassing if they are alone.
- Absolutely no swimming is permitted anywhere in the lake.
- Do not approach, feed or harass the alligators. It is against the law to feed alligators and can result in a stiff fine.
- Do not spray herbicides in the lake to treat vegetation. Our "hired" Lake Management Company is responsible for this.
